3. The crucial date for reckoning the age limit and essential qualification is the last date of receipt of application. However, age relaxation will be applicable as per Government instructions:-(i) 03 years for the candidates belonging to OBC, (ii) 05 years for the candidates belonging to SC/ST Category, (iii) 10 years for the candidates belonging to Physically Handicapped. (Additional 05 years in case of Physically Handicapped belonging to SC, ST and 03 years for OBC category), (iv) Ex-servicemen : Ex-servicemen who have rendered not less than 06 months of continuous service after attestation in the Armed forces shall be allowed to deduct the full period of such service from their actual age and if the resultant age does not exceed the prescribed maximum age by more than three years, they shall be deemed to be within age limits, (v) Departmental Employees with three years continuous service :- 40 years for UR, 43 years for OBC, 45 years for SC/ST.

4. **Mode of Selection:** Selection will be made on the basis of competitive examination which will consist of two parts (a) Written Examination of 100 marks, and (b) typing test/short hand test/trade test applicable to the post & will be of qualifying nature. The written test will consist of multiple choice questions of (i) General Intelligence and Reasoning (ii) Numerical Aptitude (iii) General English and (iv) General Awareness. Written examination will be of two (02) hours duration. The standard of written test will be based on the minimum education qualification prescribed for the post. Candidates, who qualify the written examination, will be called for typing test/short hand test/ trade test applicable to the post applied for. The number of candidates to be called for typing test/short hand test/ trade test will be five to seven times of the number of vacancies.

**Note** – Issue of admit card or calling for typing test/short hand test/ trade test do not in any manner confer any right to the offer of appointment.

5. **General Instructions:-**

- (a) Application received after due date will not be considered and Unit/Depot will not be responsible for any kind of postal delay.
- (b) Pre-scrutiny of the application in terms of age limit, essential qualification, documents and certificates will be carried out by the respective Unit/Depot before calling the suitable candidates for the written test/skill/trade/physical test.
- (c) The centre for examination for written test/skill/trade/physical test will ordinarily be the place where application is submitted and the same will be intimated to the candidate in due course.
- (d) No TA/DA will be paid for attending the written test/skill/trade/physical test.
- (e) Selected candidate will be subjected to all India Service liability.
- (f) Merely fulfilling the basic selection criteria do not automatically entitle a person to be called for written test/skill/trade/physical test.
- (g) Candidates are to bring original certificates viz. SC/ST/OBC/EWS/PwBD/ESM, educational qualification/technical qualification and experience certificates at the time of the skill/trade/physical test.
- (h) There will be simultaneous conduct of test for all categories of posts. The responsibility of deciding the category of post(s) for which the candidate would like to appear will be the choice of candidate himself.
- (j) No separate exam will be conducted for candidates applying for more than one category of posts, if the exams are held on the same date.

(k) Application should be sent by Registered/Ordinary post only. No Application will be received by hand or by courier.

(l) Incomplete application will be summarily rejected and no correspondence in this regard will be entertained.

6. **How to Apply:** The duly filled in Application in the format given herein below (neatly typed in English/Hindi on A4 size paper) and admit card along with the following documents should reach the concerned Unit/Depot on or before the last date of receipt of application:-

(a) Self attested documents in support of Education Qualification, Age, Technical Qualification, Physically Handicapped, Experience Certificate & Caste Certificate (issued by the competent civil authorities in case of SC/ST/OBC candidates) etc.

(b) In case of appointment of OBC candidates against the reserved quota, the candidates belonging to the caste of OBC listed under Central list are only eligible for appointment to Central Services. The latest rules with regard to creamy layer in OBC are to be followed. Candidates seeking reservation as OBC is required to submit a certificate alongwith application to the effect that he/she does not belong to any of the creamy layer.

(c) In case of ex-serviceman self attested photocopy of discharge book.

(d) The self attested passport size recent photograph duly affixed on the application, and two additional same passport size photographs to be attached.

(e) Self addressed (English/Hindi) envelope with stamp(s) of Rs. 25/- pasted thereon.

(f) Separate application for each post should be submitted. Applicant to mention clearly on the envelope "APPLICATION FOR THE POST OF ..... AND CATEGORY ....." and should send the application to **THE COMMANDANT/COMMANDING OFFICER OF THE CONCERNED UNITS/DEPOT** where applicant wishes to apply.

(h) Candidates will fill in the application form and Admit Card in his/her own handwriting and send it to concerned unit where they wish to apply for the concerned post by Registered/Ordinary post only.

(i) Filled in Admit Card by the applicant will be scrutinized by the concerned unit and will be sent back to the candidate at the given address.

(j) **Last date:** - The last date for receipt of Application Form in the concerned unit/depot is 30<sup>th</sup> day from the date of publication of this advertisement in Employment News i.e. **09 Aug 2021**.
